



**PEARBLOSSOM HWY  
NOTICE OF UPCOMING  
RESURFACING PAVEMENT PROJECT**



The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works will be resurfacing **Pearblossom Highway** from the **CA Aqueduct Bridge (BR1628)** to **700' W/o Sierra Highway Intersection**, adjoining to the City of Palmdale's reconstruction pavement project. The construction will be done in two phases, and is tentatively scheduled as:

- **Phase I:** August 31 to September 18, 2020 (CA Aqueduct to Sierra Hwy)
- **Phase II:** **September 21 to September 23, 2020** (Sierra Hwy Intersection to 700' feet west of Sierra Hwy) & will require **closure of the intersection** with advanced warning signs provided throughout the detour. Caltrans will close SR-14 NB Pearblossom Hwy at Sierra Hwy. Use alternate exists.

A map of the project area is included on the back side of this notice.

The resurfacing pavement project scope of work consists of cold milling 3.0" and constructing 3.0" of new pavement and reconstructing the asphalt pavement approaches at the bridge locations. Construction work will be performed within the County's road right-of-way.

With the upcoming project and necessary prep work, please be aware that the road crew will make necessary traffic control arrangements for the project's construction zone. Please note that the roadway will be closed to thru traffic and will provide local access to residents only. Alternate detour routes will be provided.
